Provided that if no suitable person is available for initial appointment, then the posts shall be filled by transfer.

3. Qualifications, Experience and Age-limit for Initial Appointment.—A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age-limit as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this notification.

Provided that the maximum age limits will be relaxed by 3 years in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Buddhist Community recognised tribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas (Districts of Gilgit, Ghanchi, Ghizar, Skardu and Diamir) in accordance with the instructions issued by the Establishment Division.

Provided further that for Government servants, who have completed at least 2 years service, maximum age-limit may be relaxed by not more than 10 years up to the age of 55 years.

4. Qualifications/Conditions for Transfer.—Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment on regular basis under the Federal Government in the same pay scale in which the post to be filled exists provided the persons concerned possess the qualifications and experience prescribed for initial appointment to the post concerned.

5. Probation.—Persons appointed by promotion or initial appointment shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of Article 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973, read with Rule 21 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973.

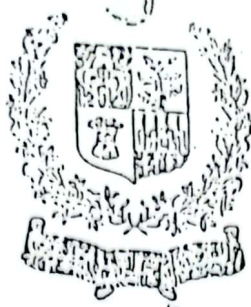

Qualifications, Experience and Age-limit for Direct Recruitment.—A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age-limits as mentioned against the post in the schedule to this Notification:

Provided that the maximum age-limit will be relaxable,—

- (i) by three years in the case of candidates belonging to the minority communities, recognized tribes of Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas (Districts of Gilgit, Ghizer, Skardu, Chumche and Diamir) in accordance with the instructions issued by the Establishment Division.
- (ii) by ten years in the case of released/retired personnel of the Armed Forces of Pakistan or by the number of years a person has actually served the Armed Forces whichever is less.
- (iii) in the case of Government servants who have completed at least 2 years' service, maximum age-limit may be relaxed by not more than 10 years up to the age of 55 years as admissible under the Establishment Division's O.M. No. 9/1/73-IV, dated 13th May, 1979.

Promotion.—Persons appointed by direct recruitment or promotion shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be extended for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded, or, if considered necessary, it may be reduced for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation is subject to the provision of Clause 6 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973.
